

Qualifying Criteria

- Applicants must satisfy the following minimum entry criteria before applying (please note that failure
 to satisfy all the requirements will lead to your application being unsuccessful)
- Applicants must be in their first year of study and applying for funding from year 2
- Applicants must be able to prove financial need and academic potential
- Applicants must display good academic potential in the fields of pure Maths, Accounting and Science
- Applicants must be have been enrolled at an institution that meets our criteria for a minimum of 6
 months at the time of application.
- School criteria includes:
- Should have a minimum of 75% academic average in both matric and semester 1
- Applicants must be South African citizens
- Please note that there are limited bursaries available
- · Meeting the minimum selection criteria does not imply that your application will be successful

What does the bursary cover?

The Tiger Brands bursary is a comprehensive bursary which includes the following:

- 100% of the prescribed university tuition fees, registration fees and exam fees
- An amount equal to the average rate for accommodation in a single room at a
 university residence at the university at which the Tiger Brands bursar is
 studying. This rate is determined by Tiger Brands in conjunction with the
 university
- An amount of guoted prescribed books and a monthly allowance

Note:

- Prescribed tuition fees, registration fees and exam fees are paid directly to the university.
- Fees for accommodation are paid directly to the university if the student is staying in university-administered accommodation Students will be required to pay for any repeat subjects.
- Book and allowance money will be paid directly to the individual.
- Payments in respect of the above are made twice a year. The first payment is made at the beginning of the first semester, and the second payment is made at the beginning of the second semester.
- Full details of the payment process and the requirements which must be met are communicated to successful applicants once a bursary contract is issued.
- Successful applicants will be bound contractually to work at Tiger Brands after graduation for a period equal to the tenure of the bursary
